<b>Prosecco Bel Canto (Vegetarian) Italy</b>	£7.00 per glass (125ml) / £31.50
<i>Delicate and aromatic with fine bubbles. This wine carries lots of fresh peach, pear and an elegant zest.</i>	
<b>Bel Canto Rose (Vegetarian) Italy</b>	£7.00 per glass (125ml) / £31.50
<i>An intense nose of a floral bouquet of roses and violets, with a light yeasty note. Fresh and full, with strawberry and raspberry notes on the palate.</i>	
<b>Chapel Down Sparkling Bacchus England</b>	£38.50
<i>Bacchus is the Ancient Greek god of wine. He's lent his name to what is now England's star grape. It's taken Chapel Down, official supplier to 10 Downing Street and the Oxford &amp; Cambridge Boat Races, 18 years to perfect the art. But it's finally arrived. It's a glorious streak of pineapple, grapefruit and elderflower that runs through arrow-precise bubbles.</i>	
<b>Nicolas Feuillatte NV, Champagne, France</b>	£48.00
<i>A light, fresh and fruity Champagne with fine discreet bubbles and subtle overtones of apples, pears and citrus fruits. Has undergone a total of 4 years' ageing prior to release.</i>	
<b>Ceil de Perdrix, Pink Champagne, France</b>	£48.00
<i>Meaning 'eye of the partridge', this pale salmon pink rose Champagne exhibits enticing complexity. Delicate in style, but with a perfect weight of fruit. A perfect aperitif.</i>	
<b>Veuve Clicquot Brut NV, Champagne</b>	£64.00
<i>Veuve Clicquot ages their non-vintage for almost twice the required time, resulting in a superb marriage of freshness and power, with rich fruit and a mouth-filling mousse.</i>

<b>Michel Servin Blanc</b>	£5.50 / £7.50 per glass (125ml / 175ml) / £23.00
<i>Light and straightforward, with an up-front nose of citrus fruit, tinged with a subtle leafy character. Crisp and dry on the palate, with a zingy finish.</i>	
<b>San Giorgio Pinot Grigio (Vegan) Italy</b>	£5.50 / £7.50 per glass (125ml / 175ml) / £24.00
<i>This is a crisp white with invigorating citrus fruit. Honeysuckle meets pear drop notes for a balanced palate.</i>	
<b>Chemin Des Dames Colombard (Vegan) French regions</b>	£24.50
<i>A medium dry wine, offering ripe honeydew melon, nectarine and pineapple fruit with an attractive sweetness.</i>	
<b>ORGANIC, Dominio de la Fuente Verdejo, Spain</b>	£25.00
<i>A crisp, aromatic white wine, showing great purity of aromas. Bright, pale straw yellow, with intense, fresh notes of grass, fennel and white pepper</i>	
<b>Fernlands Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand</b>	£28.00
<i>Wonderful balance between tropical and herbaceous flavours. Gooseberry and green pepper mingle with mango and guava.</i>	
<b>Mâcon Villages, France</b>	£31.50
<i>Fresh, clean and fruity style with subtle green apple and pear flavours with a pleasant mineral finish</i>	
<b>Chapel Down Bacchus England</b>	£7.00 / £9.50 per glass (125ml / 175ml) £32.00
<i>The warm summer of 2013 shines through giving intense aromas of grapefruit, gooseberries and freshly cut grass. Fresh with green apple and nettles flavours leaving a clean, crisp finish.</i>	
<b>Bread &amp; Butter Chardonnay USA</b>	£33.00
<i>This Chardonnay opens delicately with rich notes of vanilla bean and almond husk, which reminds us of a decadent crème brûlée. The creamy custard notes are balanced by a soft minerality.</i>

<b>Gufetto White Zinfandel Rose (Vegan) Italy</b>	£5.50 / £7.50 per glass (125ml / 175ml) £24.00
<i>Elegant rosé colour. Fresh, varietals aromas that become more complex with time. Very interesting structure due to the balance between soft tannins, acidity and residual sugar.</i>	
<b>Pinot Grigio Rosé Le Colline di San Giorgio (Vegan) Italy</b>	£5.50/£7.50 per glass (125ml/175ml) £24.00
<i>Fresh apricot and peach on the nose; soft floral flavours on the palate and a refreshing, pleasantly smooth finish.</i>	
<b>Chapel Down English Rose England</b>	£7.00 / £9.50 per glass (125ml / 175ml) £32.00
<i>Dry and refreshing, and packed with English summer fruit character. Strawberry and redcurrant characters take centre stage, with crispy acidity providing a mouth-watering lift.</i>

<i>Supple and inviting, this wine blends the soft and jammy raspberry fruit of ripe. Grenache with the firming influences of Carignan's blackberry flavours and robust tannin.</i>	
<b>Wild Ocean Cabernet/Merlot (Vegan) South Africa</b>	£5.50/£7.50 per glass (125ml/175ml) / £24.00
<i>A richly-textured velvety wine with ripe plum and blackcurrant fruit aromas and a touch of vanilla oak. Soft and juicy.</i>	
<b>Under The Sycamore Shiraz Australia</b>	£24.50
<i>Silky smooth with lashings of Blackcurrant, Bramble and white pepper.</i>	
<b>Baron de Baussac Carigan Vieilles Vingnes, Vin de Pays de L'Herault, France</b>	£25.00
<i>Deep and inky red in colour, the wine is crammed with black cherry fruit, lifted by subtle vanilla aromas from a touch of oak ageing. Bold, meaty tannins provide satisfying texture and length.</i>	
<b>Five Ravens Pinot Noir (Vegan) Romania</b>	£5.50/£7.50 per glass (125ml/175ml) £26.00
<i>Romania may not be the first place you think of when you are looking to buy a Pinot Noir but this has all the classic bright red fruit flavours and spicy note you would expect.</i>	
<b>Aires Andinos Malbec, Argentina</b>	£26.00
<i>Deep ruby coloured with smokey black fruits of cassis, blackberry &amp; spice.</i>	
<b>Marques de Postulado Rioja</b>	£28.00
<i>A harmonious balance between sweet spice and black fruits of the forest. This is a smooth, velvety Rioja.</i>	
<b>Domaine du Sabot Beaujolais Villages (Vegetarian) Beaujolais</b>	£32.00
<i>Packed with juicy strawberry, raspberry and cherry fruit flavours. A bright and youthful wine with a fresh finish.</i>

<b>Elysium Black Muscat - Half Bottle 37.5CL</b>	£6.50 per glass (50ml) / £22.00
<i>Black Muscat, an under-appreciated Muscat variety, one of the very few black-skinned Muscats. Elysium is Greek for Heaven. Virtually black in colour, with a rose-like aroma, very intense on the palate and full of fantastic rich velvety fruit. One of the few wines that can stand up to chocolate puddings. Or try it poured over ice cream for the ultimate after-dinner treat</i>
